一起唱 Let's sing

Let's sing: The recording of the singing is used to demonstrate the main vocabulary and sentence structure of the lesson. Translation of the song and a simple presentation of the grammar points are provided. The song of the lesson may present more than one grammatical point. The recording of the singing consists of a child's singing slowly (the first time), a child's singing at a regular speed (the second time), and the music without a vocal accompaniment. The teacher may play the recording or using the music score provided in the book to play the music himself/herself and teach students to sing the song.



认一认 Let's learn

Let's learn: All the new words are notional words that are classified according to the topic of the lesson, and have beautiful illustrations. The teacher may make use of word cards, real objects, and other self-made teaching aids in order to support the teaching.



对对碰 Sing in pairs

Sing in pairs: This part is for singing exercises antiphonally in order to review the new words and the sentence pattern of the lesson. Students may do the word substitution exercises according to the prompts in the illustrations, or be given free rein to do expanding exercises. The recording of this part includes a demonstration of singing and music without a vocal accompaniment for substitution exercises. The teacher has the flexibility in conducting the instructive activities of this part based on students' performance.

Exercises: This part consists of interesting exercises. The content of the exercises is relevant to what is being learned in the lesson. Additionally, they present activities of making a simple handicraft. They can also be used as warming-up exercises before class, or homework after class.
