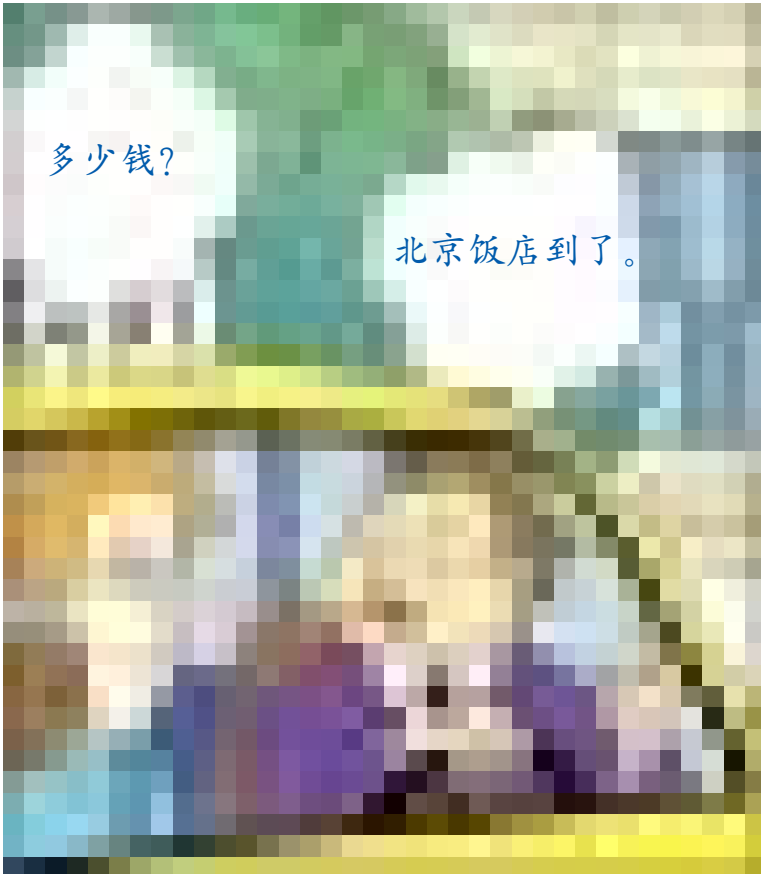


Sījī : Běijīng Fàndiàn dào le .
